- No meaningful day opportunities

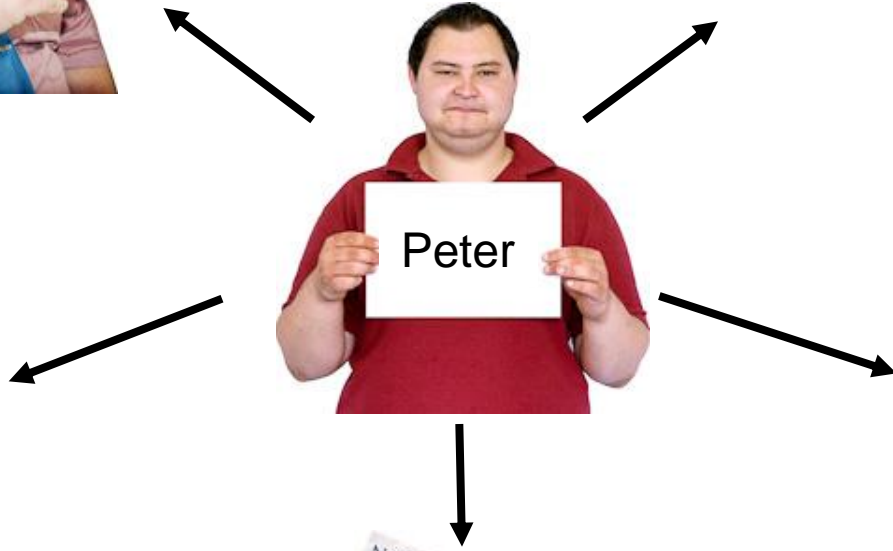


- Individuals not able to go out

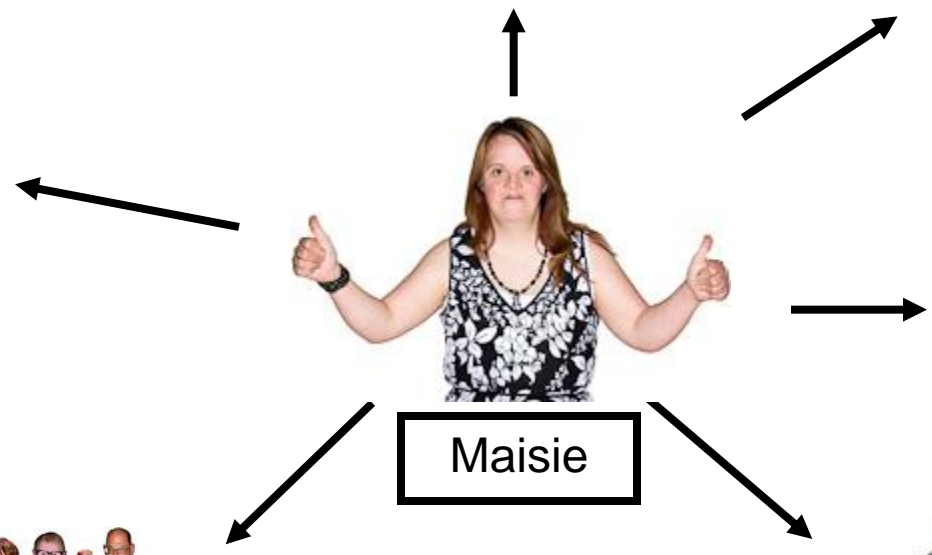

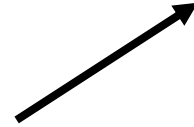

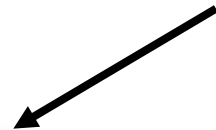
